

VILLAGE OF LOREBURN

BYLAW # 6/2024

A BYLAW TO SET ESTABLISH AND REGULATE THE COLLECTION, REMOVAL, AND DISPOSAL OF WASTE FROM THE 40 YARD BIN, TRANSFER STATION AND CONSTRUCTION CONTAINER

The Council of the Village of Loreburn in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

TITLE

- 1) This Bylaw shall be cited as “The Waste Management of the 40 Yard, Transfer Station and Construction Container Bylaw”.

DEFINITIONS

- 2) In this bylaw:
 - a) “Administrator” shall mean the administrator/clerk of the municipality;
 - b) “Municipality” shall mean the Village of Loreburn;
 - c) “Village” shall mean the Village of Loreburn;
 - d) “Council” shall mean the council of the municipality;
 - e) “Waste” shall mean bulk refuse, packaging and general household waste that is not considered hazardous to the environment;
 - f) “Hazardous” shall mean that waste defined as such in *The Hazardous Substances and Waste Dangerous Goods Regulations*, and *The Environmental Management and Protections Act, 2010*;
 - g) “Ashes” shall mean the residue of any substance used as fuel;
 - h) “Waste Management Company” shall mean person or persons who have been contracted by the Village for the purpose of removing waste;
 - i) “Users” shall mean those individuals, corporations, contractors and associations who:
 - i. Reside in the Village and wish to dispose waste
 - ii. Operate a business in the Village and wish to dispose waste
 - iii. Have been awarded a tender or contract in the Village and wish to dispose waste
 - iv. Have received designation by the Village or as an approved commercial hauler or approved municipal hauler and wish to dispose of waste.

40 YARD CONTAINER

- 3) Is located on Block 6 Lot D beside the Village Fire Hall on Saskatchewan Ave.
- 4) The 40 Yard waste area shall be enclosed by a fence. The fence will be locked at all times making it inaccessible to all users except during regular hours of operation outlined in Schedule “A” attached to this bylaw.
- 5) A Village employee shall be present during the hours of operation to ensure that authorized users do no neglect, refuse or fail to undertake any of the provisions of this bylaw.
- 6) Users will be charged a fee set by the Council of the Village of Loreburn attached to this bylaw under Schedule “B”.

WASTE TRANSFER STATION

- 7) The Waste Transfer Station shall be enclosed by a fence. The gate will be locked at all times making it inaccessible to all users. A key may be obtained from the Village Office to dispose of burnable lumber/trees/branches or leaves only.

- 8) No person shall deface or alter any signs, gates or fencing at the Waste Transfer Station.

6 YARD CONSTRUCTION CONTAINER

- 9) To rent the 6 Yard construction container, please contact the Village Office for the Rental Contract that outlines the pricing, payment and regulations

VIOLATIONS AND PENALTIES

- 10) Any person who contravenes any of the provisions of this bylaw is guilty of an offence and upon summary conviction shall be liable for the penalties provided for this Bylaw.
- 11) Anyone found tampering with a waste receptable or components of a waste site is guilty of an offence and upon summary conviction shall be liable to a penalty as follows:
1st Offence - \$200.00
All Offences thereafter - \$500.00 each occurrence
- 12) Anyone found placing waste in the Village Transfer Station, the Village 40 Yard Waste Container or the Village Construction Container that is not authorized to do so will be fined \$500.00.
- 13) Anyone found disposing of materials outside the Transfer Station, 40 Yard Waste area gates or next to the Village Construction Container will be fined \$500.00.
- 14) In addition to any penalty levied under this bylaw or the *General Penalty Bylaw*, the offender shall also be responsible for all costs incurred to rectify the damage or untidiness created by their offence.

REPEALED BYLAWS

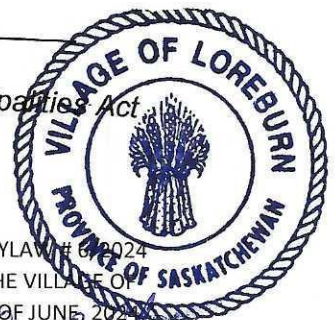
- 15) Bylaw 15-2014 is hereby repealed.
